Glossary

Below are the key words your child will be using in their classwork this half term.

Please help your child to complete the glossary and be able to use and spell the words. Feel free to add any additional topic related vocabulary that you think of.

Word	Definition
Ancient Romans	People who lived a long time ago in a place called Rome. They built big cities, roads, and were very powerful.
Empire	A large group of places or countries ruled by one person, like a king or emperor.
Conquest	When one group takes over another group or land, often by fighting.
Tribe	A group of people who live together, often sharing the same language and traditions.
Mountain	A very tall piece of land that rises high above the ground, often with a pointed top.
National Park	A special area of land where nature is protected, and people can visit to enjoy animals, plants, and beautiful views.
Muscles	The parts of your body under your skin that help you move, like when you lift your arm or run.
Tendons	Strong cords in your body that connect muscles to bones and help you move.
Quartz	A shiny, hard rock that can be clear or come in many colours, often used in jewellery.
Photosynthesis	The way plants make their own food using sunlight, air, and water.
Sediment	Tiny bits of sand, dirt, or rocks that settle at the bottom of rivers, lakes, or seas
