

### **Glossary**

Below are the key words your child will be using in their classwork this half term.

Please help your child to complete the glossary and be able to use and spell the words. Feel free to add any additional topic related vocabulary that you think of.

Word	Definition
Neolithic	Meaning 'New Stone' – the period of time from 4300-2000BC, at
	the end of the Stone Age
Hunter-Gatherer	A person who hunts for food or gathers fruit and nuts
Prehistory	The time before history was recorded
Mammoth	An extinct type of elephant
Hide	The skin and fur of an animal, used to make clothing and shelter
Stone Age	When people used stone tools and weapons for hunting and survival
Source	The place where the river begins – usually on higher ground
Estuary	The wide part of a river where it nears the sea – it contains both fresh and salt water
Water Cycle	The continuous process by which water is circulated through the environment via evaporation, condensation and precipitation
Delta	A landform that is created by sediment, where a river flows into a larger
	river, a sea or an ocean
Tributary	A stream or river the flows into a much larger river
