


Reception Spring Term 1 - 2024

Over this term, your child will be working on:

- Reading phrases and simple sentences.
- Reading all phase 2 and phase 3 tricky words by sight.
 - Different modes of transport and how they work.
 - We will be reading lots of books linked to transport.
- Recognising numbers to 10 and making different arrangements with numbers.
 - The Chinese New Year celebration.
 - People who help us in our community.

Routines
